



**CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION
INTERNATIONAL 3D VIDEO MAPPING CONTEST
INTERNATIONAL FESTIVAL OF LIGHT
KYIV LIGHTS FESTIVAL 2019**

1. The Contest is an international contest of audiovisual artworks comprised of 2D-3D light projections on architectural structures in an urban environment, which take into account their geometry and spatial positioning, and are accompanied by music and/or narration (hereafter - Works).

1.1 Contest Venue:

Kyiv, Kyiv City State Administration building (36 Khreshchatyk street)

1.2. Video content duration:

The duration of each video's content for the 3D Mapping Contest shall not exceed 7 minutes.

1.3. Dates of the Contest: September 28 - 29, 2019.

1.4. Selection and Assessment Criteria:

- Plot Integrity
- Technique
- Creativity & Originality
- Coherence between audio and video

1.5. Winners are selected on a competitive basis.

1.6. Contest Works may be presented by a single author or a group of authors. The right to submit Works to the Contest is granted to both Ukrainian and Foreign individuals as well as legal entities.

1.7. The number of Works allowed to be submitted to the Contest by a single author or group of authors is not limited.

2. The Contest Jury and its routine

2.1. The Contest Organizer forms a Jury to judge the Contest.

2.2. The Jury consists of reputable Ukrainian and International multimedia design experts, artists, art historians and other prominent culture and art professionals.

2.3. The Jury session achieves a quorum if it is attended by more than three judges.

2.4. The Jury's decision is recorded in a protocol. The protocol shall be signed by the chairman and all the judges in the Jury. The signed protocol is stored in the archives of the Contest Organizer for 3 (three) years.

2.5. The Jury's decision is announced at the Contest award ceremony.

2.6. The Works shall not be reviewed or returned.

3. Prizes and Money Prizes

3.1. The winners are awarded with certificates and money prizes.

3.2. The nomination 3D Video Mapping. The prize fund:

1 place - 135,000 UAH

2 place - 80,000 UAH

3 place - 55,000 UAH

3.3. Individuals and companies interested in developing light design and art technologies have the right to approach the Contest Organizer with a proposal for presenting the Contestants with additional awards.



4. Contest Structure

The Contest has two stages:

4.1 The first stage

To participate in the first stage of the Contest, it is necessary to:

4.1.1. **by August 9, 2019**, fill in the Participant registration form on the Festival's website – kyivlights.com

4.1.2. **by August 16, 2019**, send the following to contest@kyivlights.com:

1. Presentation of the Work, which shall include up to 10 slides or the Work's preview with a resolution that does not exceed 1920X1080 pixels, with a short description of the idea and scenario.
2. Information about the audio piece (author, rights owner), which will be used in the Work.

4.1.3. **The first stage selection results will be announced on August 27, 2019. Contestants admitted to the second stage will be informed by email.**

4.2. Second Stage

4.2.1. **By September 23, 2019 the final Work shall be submitted.**

The selected works will be demonstrated on the contest venue and will be judged by the International Jury.

The Work shall meet the the technical specification posted on the website.

4.3. The starting materials are available for download on the website.

4.4. The Organizer shall verify the content and technical parameters of the Works submitted.

4.5. The Contest Organizer has the right to refuse to accept and show any Work without explanation.

4.6. The final works shall be displayed at the Venue over the course of three days of the Contest.

5. Contestant's Guarantees

Each Contestant shall guarantee to have full copyright or rights to use the work submitted to the Contest, in manner and by means described in these Terms; insofar as any Contestant's Work does not violate any copyrights, associated and/or patent rights, rights to means of identification or any other intellectual property rights, other proprietary or personal rights of any third party. The Contestant shall also guarantee that the Work does not harm the honor, dignity and/or reputation of the third parties. The Contestant guarantees to resolve on his/her own initiative and at his/her own expense any possible claims of any third party. **By submitting the Contest application, any Contestant is deemed to agree and accept all the terms and conditions hereof.**
